A World of Difference.

- No other country has a range of indigenous grape varieties to match Portugal's. This huge palette of different grapes was developed in the country from the mutations of Iberian Vitis silvestris
- The quality and range of its native varieties (+250) enables the country to make a great diversity of wines with distinctive personalities
- The more than 250 native grapes and the range of climates and types of soils contribute to the diversity of Portuguese wines
- A high investment was made in scientific research in order to determine the potential in wine making for each of the many distinctive varietals
- Portugal has fought the genetic erosion of its native grape varieties in order to preserve the wealth of its genetic diversity. In this way has avoided the standardization of its wines according to global standards
- Portugal has not forgotten also the protection of the several clones within each varietal

Terroir

- Portuguese wines are wines of *Terroir*:
 - Centuries of experience in wine making to make the wines fully express their *terroir*
 - Openness to new ideas and experiments in order to take the most out of the potential of each *terroir*
- Each varietal is well adapted to the diversity of terroirs in the country



A Word of Difference.

The Art of Blend

Portuguese winemakers are Masters of Blends – a great tradition and experience of blending from the multi-variety palette.

- They strive for the discovery of unique sensorial experiences through the art of combining different varietals
- They preserve Old Vineyards and Field Blends: mix of different varietals in a single plot giving rise to more complex and full body wines, with long-living aromas
- They bring the expertise of blending even to single variety wines: mix of grapes from different plots, mix of grapes on different altitudes, mix of grapes from different types of soils, mix of grapes from different sun exposure and even different clones of the same varietal



A Word of Difference.

Unforgotten Traditions

Portugal's master winemakers combine rich heritage and traditional methods with state of the art technology to produce unique wines

- "Pisa a Pé" Foot treading and fermentation in "lagar" (open tanks)
- "Vinho de Talha" Fermentation in amphoras (clay pots)
- "Vinho de Curtimenta" White wine made like a red wine, with skin contact during fermentation

- The country has been able to preserve the genetic diversity of its varieties. Portugal is the country with the highest density of native grape varieties in Europe.




















Portugal... a World inside a Country Soil types
